Ndenga has started his first rotation in the graduate programme within the Global Risk Analysis Team.

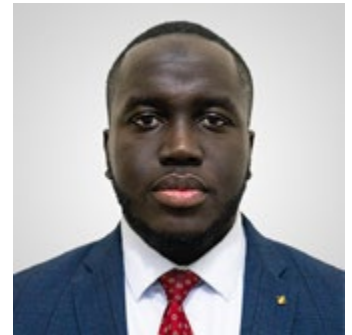


Omobolade Olagunju
